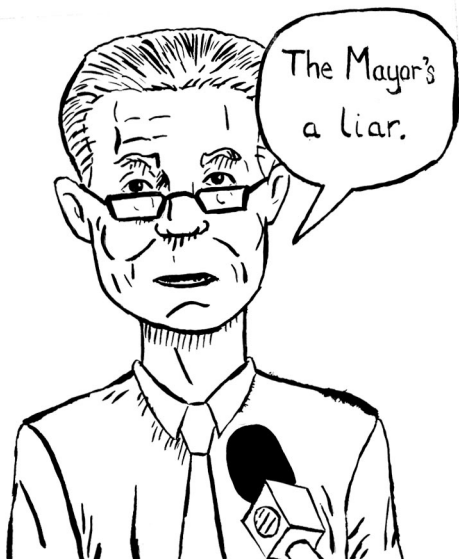
Despite years of protest,
